About Us

Furniture for Families Inc. is a 501©3 non-profit charitable organization in the Killeen-Fort Hood-Harker Heights-Nolanville-Copperas-Cove & Bell County Area. As a local affiliate of Furniture Bank Association of North America, it collects/stores gently used, basic household furniture -- cribs, beds, dressers, sofas, tables, chairs, and other selected home furnishings -- through donations from the furniture industry, businesses, hotels, motels, and individuals from the community. The collected basic furniture items are provided free of charge to those in need as recommended by our Collaborative Partner Agencies. Through this process, FFF is providing another alternative for good quality, gently used, furniture when the owner is ready to buy something new.

The idea for the establishment of a local furniture bank was led by Sandra Vale Skinner and her husband Ronnie. They own and operate the Ashley Furniture HomeStore and Furniture Zone Sleep Shops in Killeen and Copperas Cove. Sandra grew up with her family in the furniture business. Her parents, Eddie & Marilyn Vale, first came to Killeen and opened Furniture Factory Outlet on Business Hwy 190 in 1964.

Sandra has solicited the involvement of Woodrow (Woody) Hall, past Chief Professional Officer of Clements Boys & Girls Club, and many others. A cadre of supporters from the Centroplex Area will help fill some basic needs of our transient community.

Social service agencies, churches, civic organizations, and businesses who become **Collaborating Partner Agencies** of FFF (for a small annual fee of \$100) will be able to pre-qualify and recommend clients to Furniture for Families for needed items. Working families, battered women/children in retreat, disadvantaged veterans, and victims of natural disasters who manage to find affordable housing are often faced with a harsh reality. The home is empty - without beds for the children, a chest for clothes, a table on which to eat, or even a couch on which to sit together. After basic expenses such as rent, utilities, and food are paid, there is little left for the common household furnishings most people take for granted.

Requests for furniture come from one of our FFF Collaborating Partner Agencies (listed at the right) who will pre-qualify the need and complete an official "FFF Furniture Request Form."

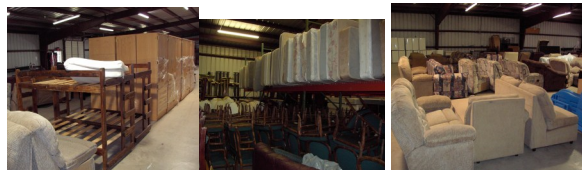
The CPA agency will forward the completed form to FFF Executive Director Woody Hall. Woody will review & approve or reject the request and forward the pertinent information to the FFF warehouse staff, who will contact the CPA/client and arrange for delivery of requested items which are available.

Likewise, furniture donations (other than the ones made to Ashley or Zone staff at point of sale) should be sent to Woody with contact information and a description of the donation. FFF/Ashley staff will then contact the donor to arrange the pickup. Donations can be dropped off at the FFF Warehouse 9-5 M-F.
